# **Survey Methodology**

American Strategies designed and administered this survey conducted by professional interviewers. The survey reached 400 adults, age 18 or older, who indicated they were registered to vote in Milwaukee, WI. The survey was conducted March 10-14, 2022.

Seventy-six percent of respondents were reached on wireless phones, ten percent on VOIP phones, and fourteen percent on landlines. Quotas were assigned to reflect the demographic distribution of registered voters in Milwaukee, WI, and the data were weighted to ensure an accurate reflection of the population. The sample was drawn from a third-party vendor file. The overall margin of error is +/- 4.9%. The margin of error for subgroups is larger and varies. Percentage totals may not add up precisely due to rounding.
